OCTOBER 2018 REPORT

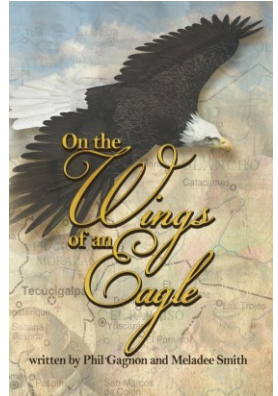
My presence in the July pastors' conference in Honduras is bearing fruit. As written in my book, pastors who begin local church institutes duplicate our ministry. Pray for these men!

Pastor Ernesto Rosales wrote from San Martín, El Salvador: Thank you for the opportunity for our church to become a seminary extension.

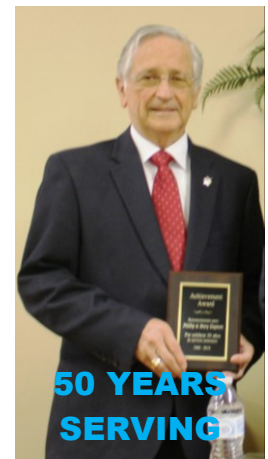
